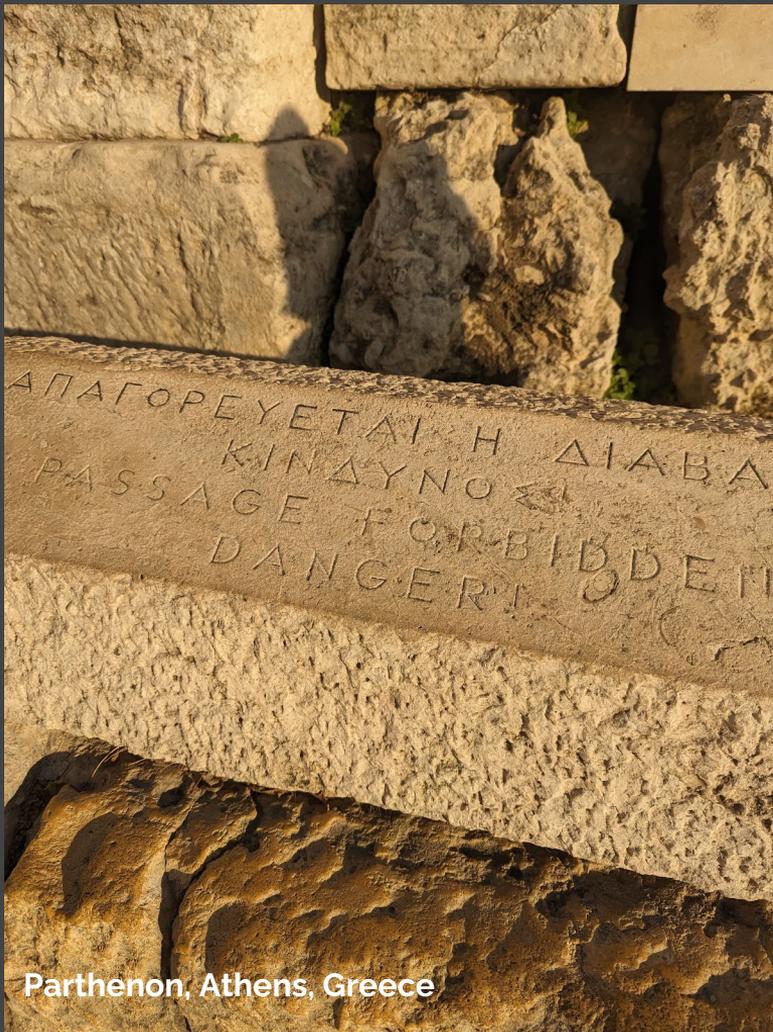

Financial Risk Reduction

Network Resiliency

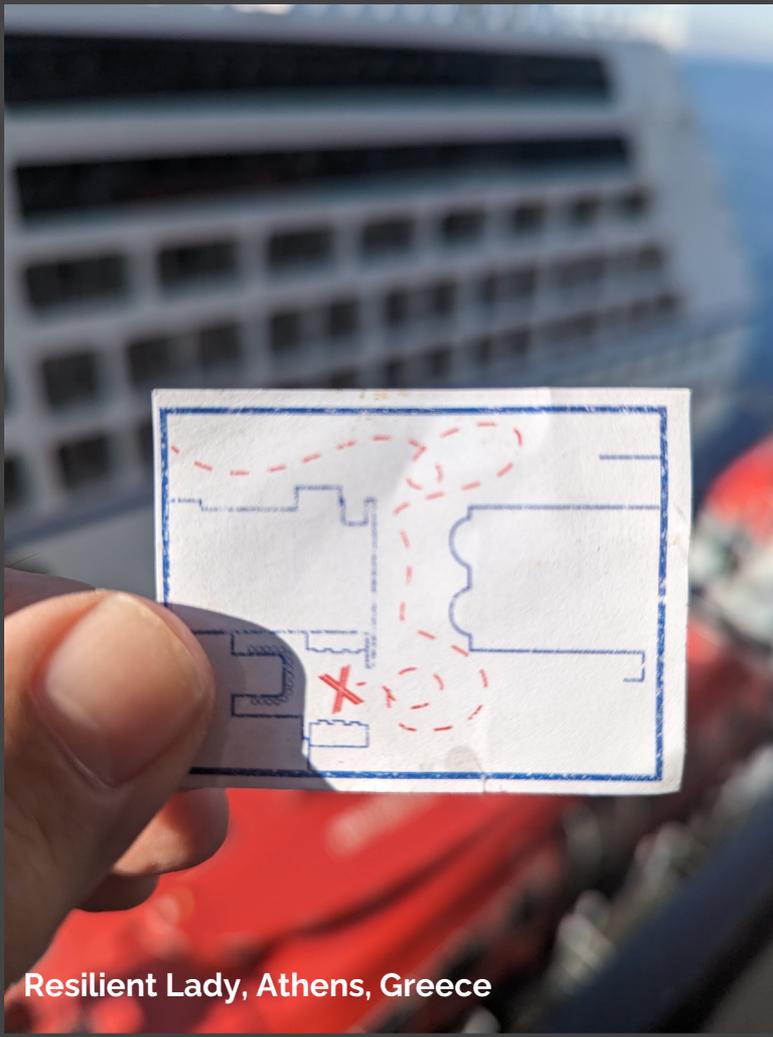
Copper is \$3.74/lb and melts easily.
